**Environmental Review of Dust Stop Municipal Blend**

As requested by Cypher Environmental Ltd., the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (ENR) reviewed information provided by you related to use of Dust Stop Municipal Blend, a dust suppressant product of Cypher Environmental Ltd. ENR's review was conducted in accordance with the Environmental Guideline for Dust Suppression and the Northwest Territories (NWT) *Environmental Protection Act*.

ENR determined that Dust Stop Municipal Blend will not pose a significant adverse environmental impact to the terrestrial or atmospheric environment if used in accordance with the manufacturer's recommendations which include: dose concentration and method of application. ENR's assessment is based on Material Safety Data Sheet and toxicological information provided by Cypher Environmental Ltd., correspondence with the company and additional research.

This authorization is valid for the application of Dust Stop Municipal Blend on Commissioner's Land, within communities and on NWT roads or highways. ENR does not have the authority to permit the use of this product on lands or at facilities (i.e. mine sites) authorized under a Land Use Permit and/or Water License, issued by the applicable Land and Water Board for a given region. Application of this product must adhere to the following conditions to prevent potential significant adverse environmental impacts:

- It must be applied in accordance with the Environmental Guideline for Dust Suppression.
- The manufacturer's application specifications (including application process and dilution/strength of solution) must be followed.

- The application of Dust Stop Municipal Blend must be confined to the road surface and prevented from entering any surface water.
- Application of Dust Stop Municipal Blend to roadways must not occur within 30m of any surface water, including rivers, creeks, or waterbodies.

ENR reviewed and assessed the product for environmental implications; however, this assessment did not include the effectiveness or performance of this product as a dust suppressant, its ease of application, longevity in storage or in-situ, economic benefit, or any secondary effects to road conditions.

This authorization does not absolve the applicator of any other federal, territorial or municipal permits, authorizations or requirements that may apply.
